

Dealing with Diversity is an 18 months project promoted by Sirius Training CIC, with partner organisations from Bulgaria, Romania and Lithuania.

The aim of the project is to promote social inclusion and respect for diversity and to share best practices among partner organisations. The project aims to develop a culture of diversity in order to facilitate the inclusion of young people belonging to minorities. strategies to promote respect for diversity.

Through the project the following activities will take place:

- Two international training events. The first event will take place in Bulgaria from 19-23 July 2019 and the second will be in Lithuania from 9-13 March 2020. The format will be: first and last day for travel, and 3 full days of training. During the training each partner will be in charge of delivering some workshops. The workshops will be the following:
 - o 1st training event: Introduction to cultural diversity and tolerance (RO), Theatre of the oppressed (BG), three-sided football (LT), Journalist genres (RO), Storytelling (UK), Cooking (BG), Stencil Graffiti (RO), Statue Theatre (UK), Street art (all partners)
 - o 2nd training event: news and articles as citizen journalists (RO), Fanzines (UK), Fitness exercises, e.g. pilates, to increase tolerance levels among youths (UK), tolerance vs intolerance role play (BG), Flash mob (UK), Volleyball with bed sheets (LT), mail art (RO), raising awareness campaign (all partners).
- Organisation of local events: after each training event each partner will organise one local activity with local youths where they will be trained using some of the techniques learnt during the international training events.
- Creation of a website (dealingwithdiversity.eu) and a Youtube Channel. The website is already live although it's still under construction. There will be a section where we will upload all videos produced by each partner. Each partner will produce videos on a regular basis promoting diversity (it could be simple interviews, or events, etc.).
- Dissemination events: each partner will organise 3 events throughout the project to promote its outcomes.

We are looking for 3 members of staff or volunteers who would like to take part in each training. The requisites are the following:

- Interest in the topics of the project
- Ability to take part in the trainings as learners as well as delivering some workshops, according to the pre-established topics (as above)
- Willingness to cooperate with the project promoter in the organisation of local trainings for local youths
- Willingness to organise dissemination events to promote the project to the larger community.
